

Visual Learners

- information on the whiteboard
- flashcards
- posters
- worksheets
- videos



Pictures

With pictures we can:

- teach, practice, or review new vocabulary
- do guided practice (drills)
- practice grammatical structures
- practice listening comprehension
- do writing activities
- do semi-guided or free speaking practice such as problem solving activities, role plays, discussions, etc.

Depending on the purpose of the activity, a task can take up five minutes **at the beginning or end of a class**, or last 20 minutes or more in the main part of the class.

Video

Three-part activity:

- **pre-viewing** (reading activity, discussion of new vocabulary, looking at still pictures from the video and predicting language and content to be covered, technical details)
- **viewing** (press the pause, rewind, and play buttons as needed, complete worksheets, answer the questions)
- **post-viewing** (review and clarify complex points, encourage discussion, and explain and assign follow-up activities)
